 - O What is David's response?
 - o How do you respond to someone who is harsh with you?
 - Do you respond or think about how you should respond first?
- Read 1 Samuel 25:30-31
 - O What does Abigail remind David?
 - That he will be king in the future.
 - How can considering the long-view deter you from impulsive decisions?
 - O How does knowing a preferred future guide your decisions today?
 - What steps/decisions are you taking today that will negatively impact you in the future?
 - What steps/decisions are you taking today that will positively impact you in the future?
