- Read 1 Samuel 16:1-5
 - Have you ever made plans that didn't work out the way you wanted them to?
 - Saul's story in brief: 1 Samuel 8:4-7; 9:1-2, 15-17; 10:20-24;
 13:8-14 (I would just paraphrase this story for your group)
 - How do you think this made Samuel feel?
 - Who chose the next king?
 - Do you trust God to work in your life like this?
 - What is one area of your life that you need trust God more with?
 - What was Samuel afraid of?
 - Have you ever been scared of the consequences of doing the right thing?
 - (give a couple of people a chance to share examples)
- <u>Read 1 Samuel 16:6-13</u>
 - Do you ever make snap judgments on outward appearances?
 - Can there be a difference between what someone puts on display and what is actually in their heart?
 - Is that ever true of you?
 - Do you think Jesse and Samuel began getting frustrated with this process?
 - Do you think Jesse even considered David a viable candidate?
