- Read 2 Samuel 7:8-17
 - David wanted to build the temple, but God said no
 - How do you feel when God says no to your plans?
 - This passage is known as the Davidic Covenant
 - This is a promise from God that David's descendants would be the royal representatives of his people and would culminate in Jesus.
 - What did David have to do to earn this?
 - Nothing – God always plans to give more than He receives back!
 - How is David's response (18-29) an example for us?
- Read Matthew 26:26-29
 - What is the covenant Jesus is making here?
 - That Jesus' blood will forgive our sins!
 - Knowing that Jesus' promises to forgive our sins, how does that make you live your life?
 - How can this impact us even when God says no to us?
